



INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY DAY 2017

Property Right: A basic constitutional right!

The International Union of Property Owners' annual International "Property Day" will take place in Warsaw on 20 October 2017 to promote the constitutional protection of property ownership and reflect on current challenges to an equal enjoyment of this right.

Hosted by the Polish member of UIPI, PUWN (Polska Unia Właścicieli Nieruchomości - Polish Union of Property Owners), the Property Day celebration will bring together representatives of property owners' associations from all over Europe to highlight the importance of the constitutional guarantee of property right in contemporary Europe, notably in light of a potential revision of the Polish Constitution. It will also be the occasion to reflect on how this right is exercised in modern times. The keynote speeches will be held by Dr. Marcin Świącicki, a Member of the Polish Parliament and Former Minister as well as Former Mayor of Warsaw, and Prof. Dr. Geoffrey Grandjean, Lecturer at the University of Liège in Belgium.

The Official Property Day celebration will be preceded by UIPI Board and Working Committees meetings on 19 October.
